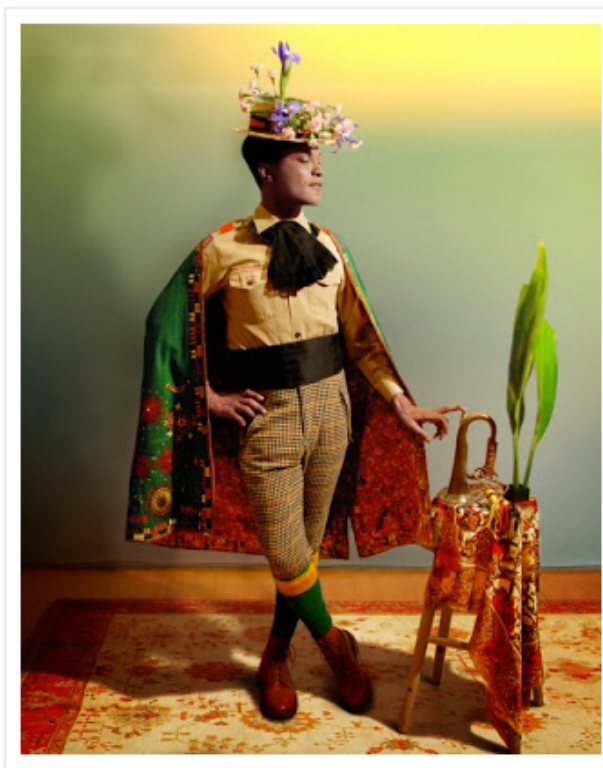

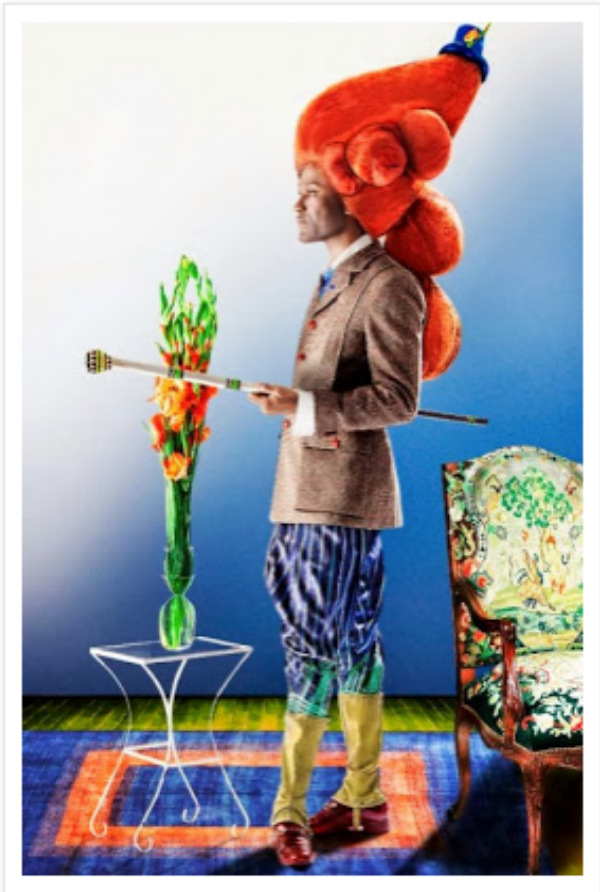

## "Style and Sympathies", A collection by Iké Udé

Nigerian born artist Iké Udé will be exhibiting his collection "Styles and Sympathies" at the Leila Heller Gallery in New York from October 10, 2013 to November 9, 2013.
